In the last fortnight, Goulburn East has had two students represent the school at State Championships, Abdul Aleem in cricket and Connor Diggins in athletics.

Aleem played cricket for the NSW PSSA State Cricket Championships in the small rural town of Barooga, which is close to the border of NSW and Victoria. Aleem's family travelled to Barooga to support him on this adventure. Aleem is an all-rounder, meaning he is a batter, bowler and fielder - a very important player for the team. The South Coast Cricket team were very competitive and they came away from the championship being 3rd in the State.

Connor participated in the NSW PSSA State Athletics Championships in Sydney in the 100m dash. Connor has been training very hard lately to improve his running technique. As a result, Connor made it through to the semis on the second day. Connor finished the Championships as the 12th fastest 12 year boy in the State.

PEER SUPPORT

We have commenced our Peer Support lessons for term 4. The whole school participates in Peer Support for 30 minutes each Friday. In pairs, two year 6 leaders facilitate a small group of 12-15 younger students, working together on a number of activities. We are working on a module called 'Keeping Friends', which explores the concepts of friendship, building relationships and developing skills in empathy and critical thinking. Our first session enabled the children to get to know everybody in their group, agreeing on how they will work together and interact cooperatively with others. We encourage you to talk to your children about Peer Support every week as it will help reinforce the concepts learned in each session.

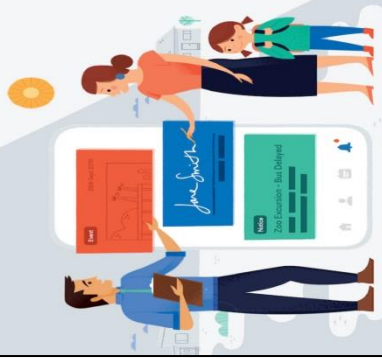

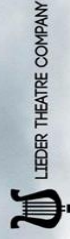
