Playgroup is held in the Goulburn East hall each Tuesday during school terms from 9.25am – 11.00am.

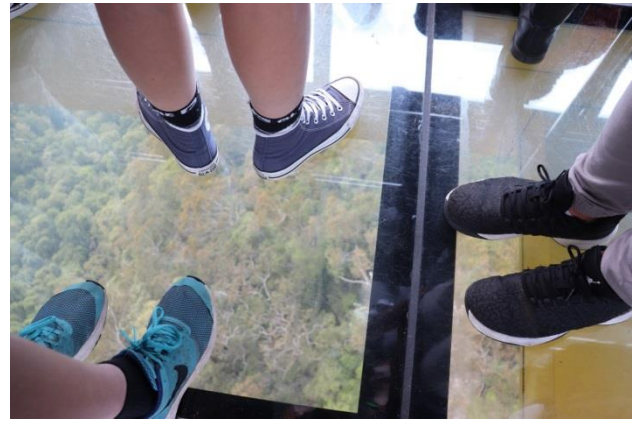

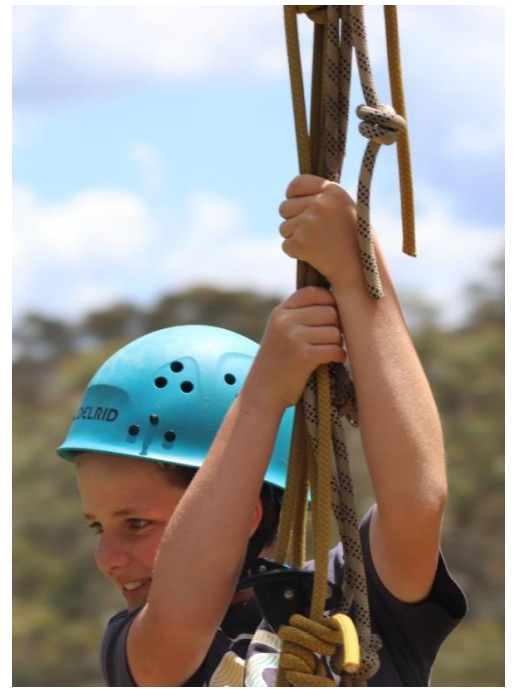

The competition is split into three categories, children under 12 years, teens 13-18 years and adults.

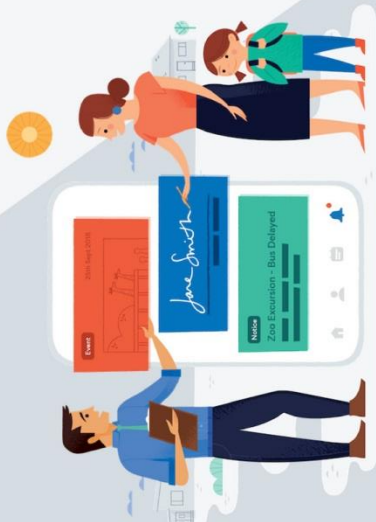
There are great prizes to be won. Entries will be displayed at Goulburn Comic Con on 16 March 2019.
