Congratulations to our Swimming School students and teachers for coping with the wind and varying temperatures over the last fortnight. Due to the closure of the indoor pool, all lessons have been held outside. It has been wonderful to have had the assistance of our student teachers, Thomas Foley and Chloe Wursten, with these sessions.

I spoke at the last assembly about our school commencing Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL). This is a system which will take a few years to embed fully into our school culture and practices. Our starting point was to choose three expectations to replace our previous four values. These are **Respect, Responsibility and Commitment**. Each of these expectations will be explicitly taught to students using lessons written by our teachers so that everyone understands what they mean and how to demonstrate them.

As part of PBL, we also have our school **Rockies.** These are handed out to students to recognise positive behaviour promptly in the classroom and around the school. Each class is collecting their Rockies in a jar as they work towards our PBL Reward Disco next Friday afternoon, run by the Student Council. There is no cost for this disco.

As a school, we realise that we are fortunate not to have been affected by the recent fires, nor are we significantly affected by the drought to the extent of other parts of the state.

Details will come home tomorrow about ways in which our school would like to show our support for those less fortunate.


