These holidays were a little bit different! In K/1J we loved hearing about what everyone got up to and completed some amazing writing. Well done K/1J, keep up the wonderful work!

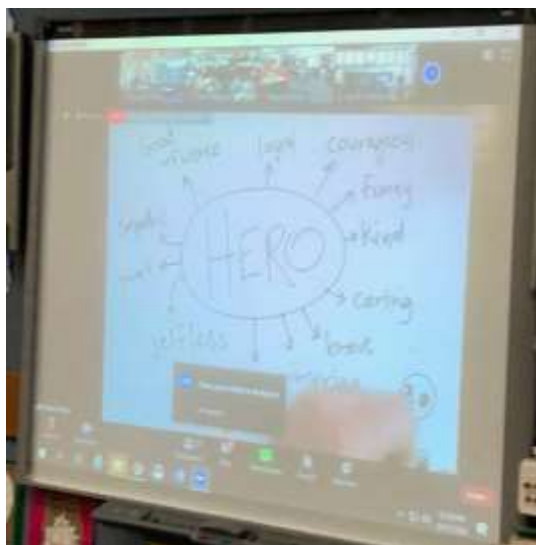


# Littlescribe Mini-Writing Festival

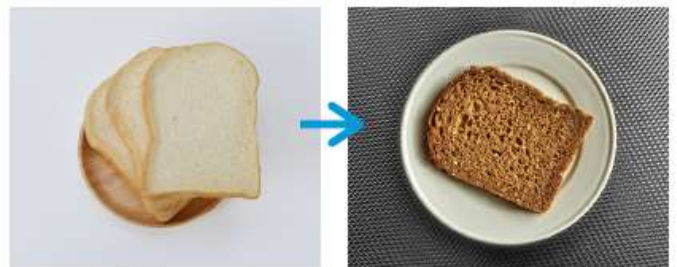
