### Key things to know about *Share Our Space* at Goulburn East

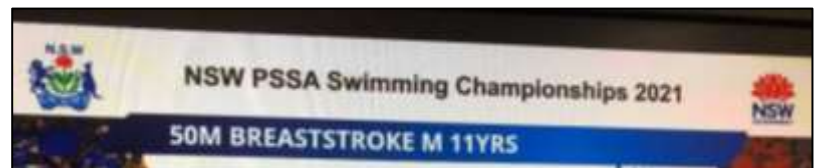
- Share Our Space will be operating at several Goulburn schools in the holidays from Monday 5 April - Friday 16 April but not on weekends.

Our school will appear in 'Nearby Locations' if you're within 10kms of the school, or search for our school by name.

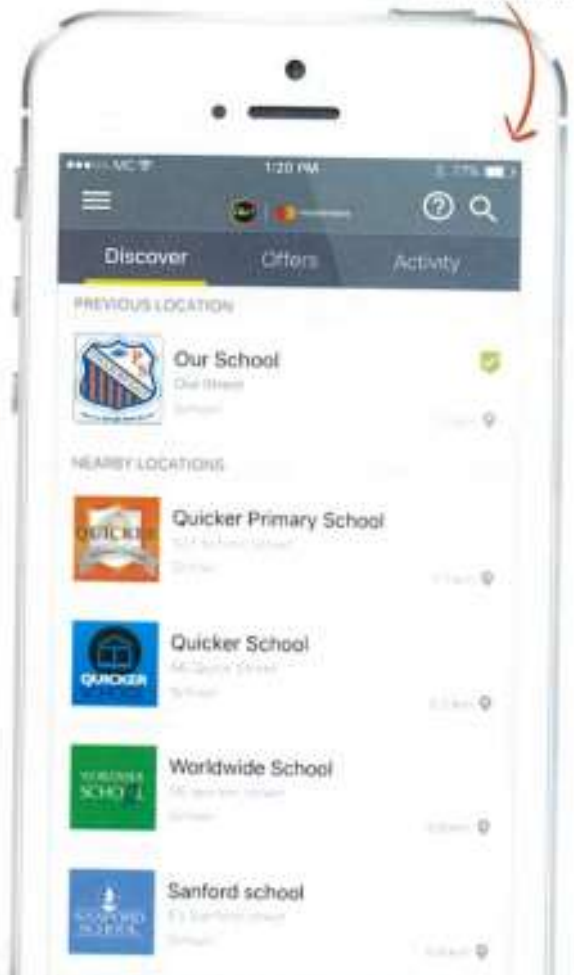
### Step 4 Register your children
