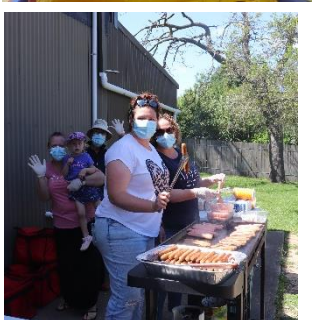
# Obstacle Course & Sausage Sizzle
