The Compass Parent Portal is an online portal that allows you to access up-to-date information about out school and your child's progress.

The portal is accessible via the web and via the Compass School Manager App (available for download via the App store on your device)

Your child will bring home your personal log-in details today, along with the Compass Parent Guide.

This guide will assist you with navigating the portal and includes step by step information on how to complete key processes.

In this guide we provide information on how to access and log in to the Compass App and how to submit an absence notification. We will gradually introduce more features as staff become familiar with Compass. We appreciate your patience during this learning period.
