Our students in Years 3 and 5 will start NAPLAN – National Assessment of Literacy and Numeracy – next week. This is a series of four assessments in writing, reading, language conventions and numeracy. For the first time these assessments are being held earlier in the year. Teachers and parents will be able to see the strengths of the students in literacy and numeracy and identify areas of focus for future learning. All assessments are completed online except for the Year 3 Writing which is still a pencil and paper test. We design our assessment timetable so that students are able to complete their work in a supportive and encouraging environment.

We currently have some payments outstanding for school events and performances. Sometimes permission notes come through on Skoolbag but are not followed up with payment. Please check with the office if you are unsure whether a payment is outstanding. Sometimes it can be hard to pay for something quickly. It is very important that you let me know if you need some assistance when there is an event at school requiring payment.
