
Extended Leave (Travel) application form

If you are planning a holiday during the school term of 5 days or more, an Extended Leave (Travel) application form should be filled out prior to your holiday.

These forms are now on School Bytes. Go to forms on your portal and select 'Forms' and then 'Extended Leave (Travel) application form'.

Reminder that the first date of absence to the last date of absence is inclusive.

Eg: from Monday 4 November to Friday 8 November will equal 5 days absence.

Kindergarten enrolments are now being taken for children who live in the Goulburn East zone and will turn 5 years old before 31 July 2025.

Please note that original documents will need to be sighted at the office, and 100 points of proof of address documents must be provided in accordance with the Residential Address Checklist which is available from the school office.

To finalise your child's enrolment, you will need to bring along:

- Your child's birth certificate
- Your child's immunization certificate (available from Medicare)
- Proof of address documents


Heathy Harold




